One common set of international standards for e-trade

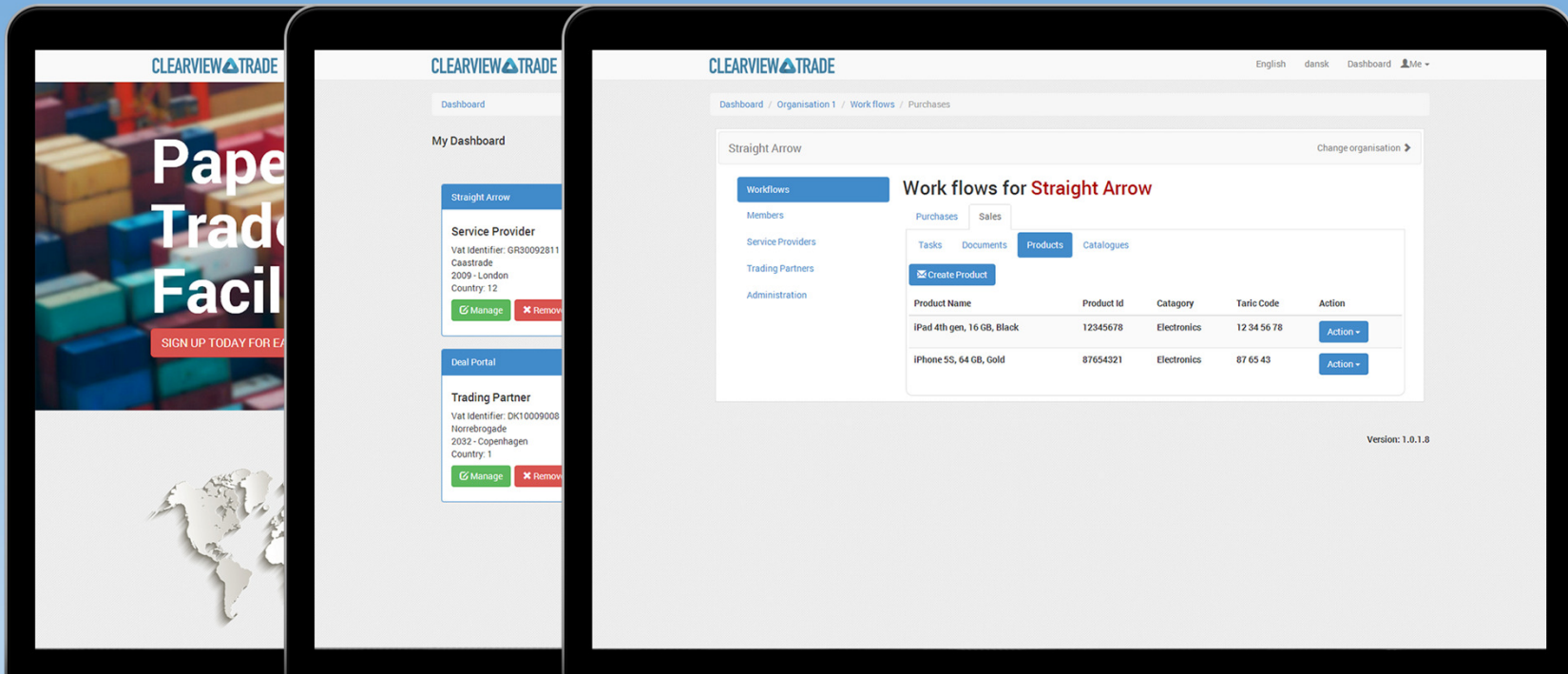
Trade data before goods

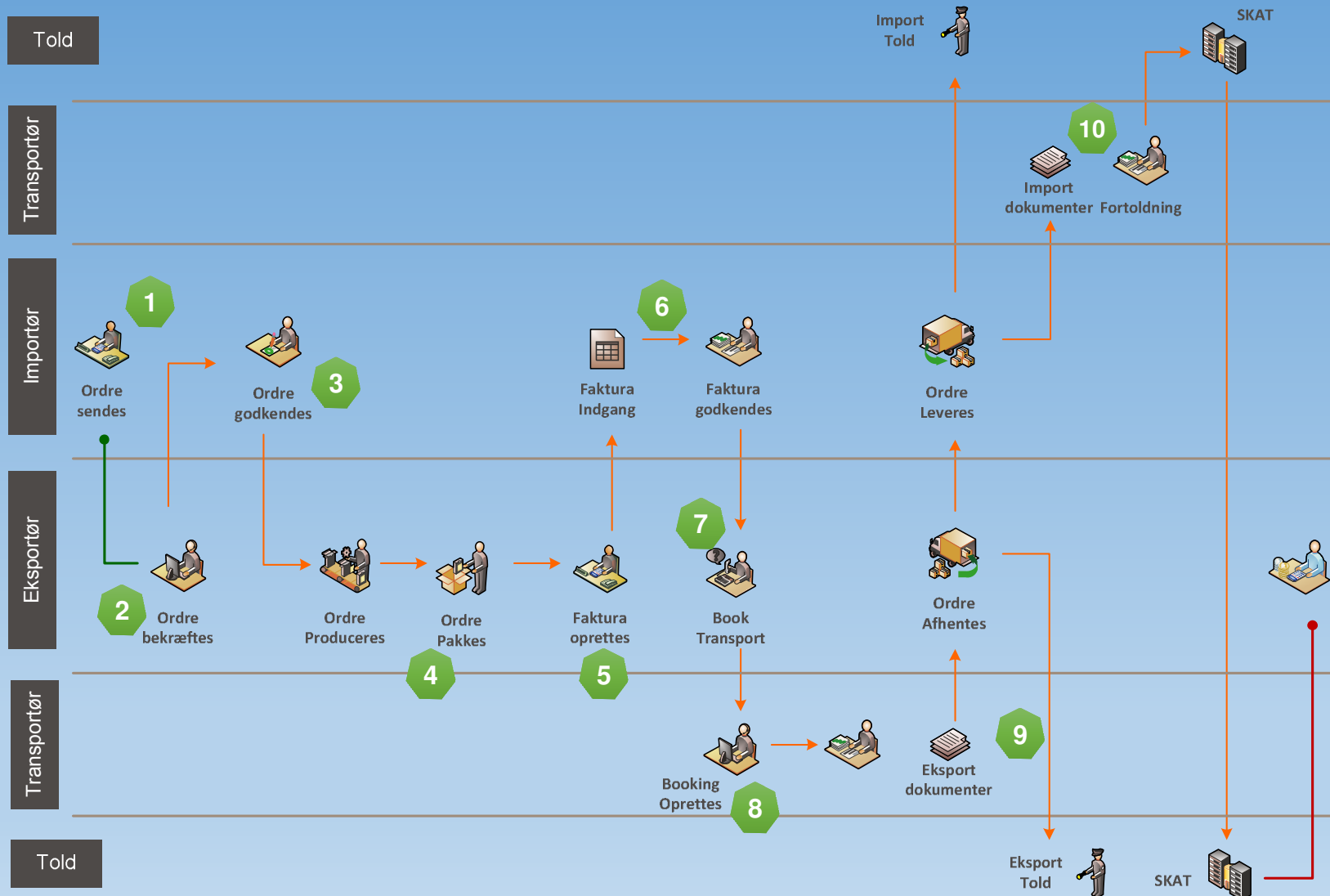

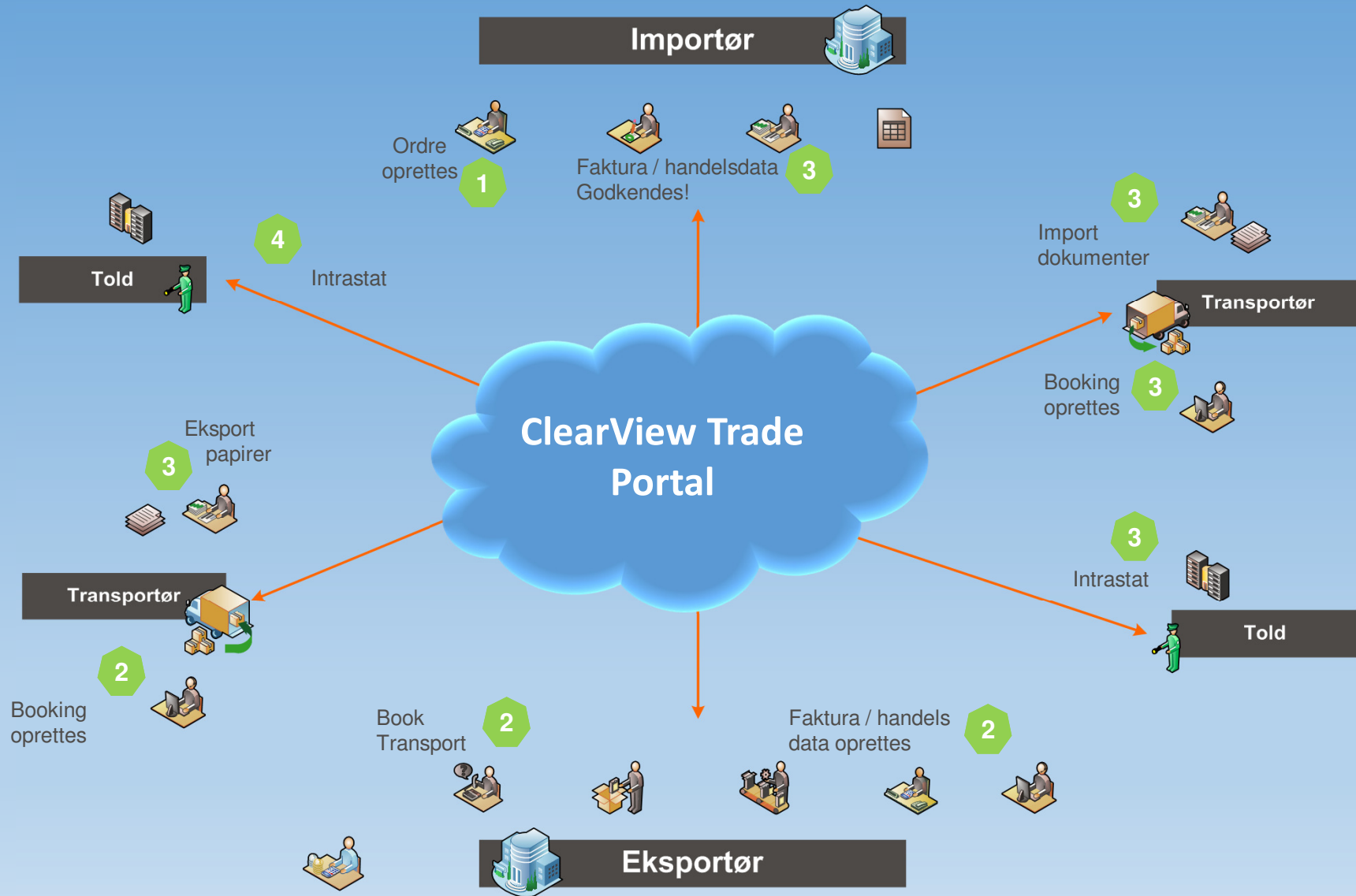
From Purchase order to Customs handling



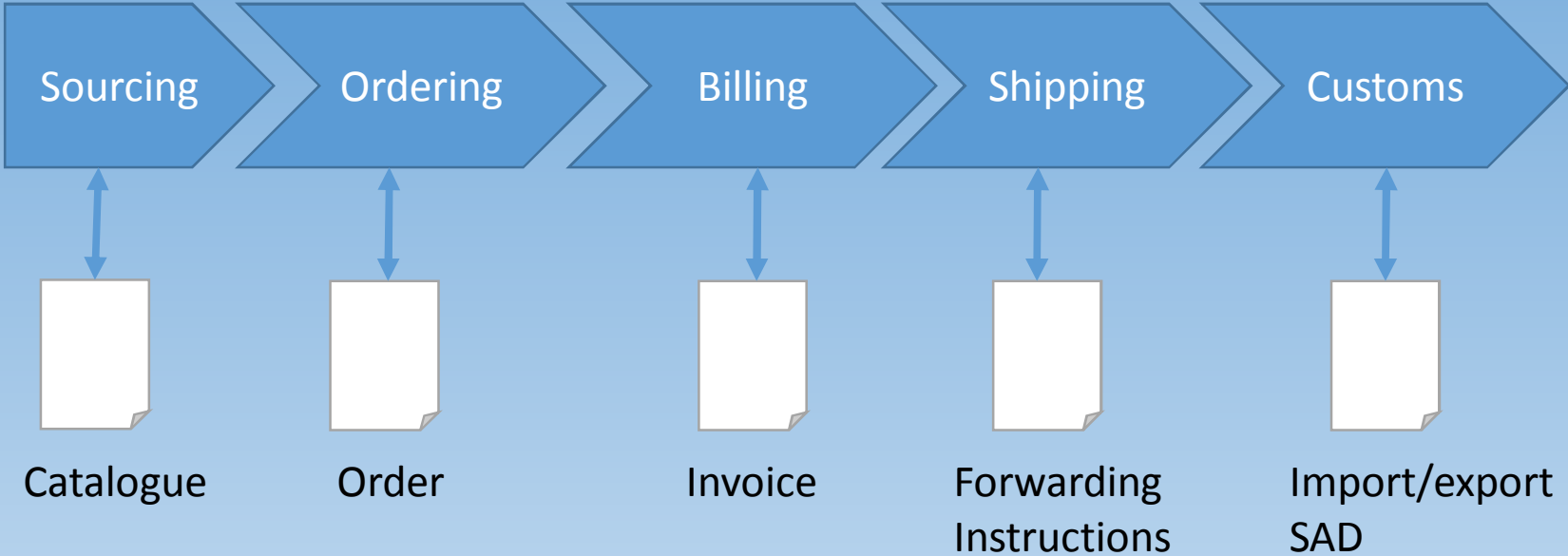
Fragmentet Tradeflow | As-Is
